

ABSTRACTS GUIDELINES

STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACT (A4 format, maximum length one page)

Language: Italian is the official language of the SIPI, nevertheless, English abstracts will also be taken in consideration and published.

Title: Font Times New Roman 11, uppercase, Bold (italics should be used for scientific names), single line spacing

Authors: Font Times New Roman 10 (Author's Surname followed by initial of the Name), single line spacing. Authors should be tagged with exponential numbers indicating their Affiliations.

Affiliations: Font Times New Roman 9, italics (full description of the Institution and location), single line spacing.

Title, Authors and Institutions should be separated using double line spacing.

Text of the abstract: Font Times New Roman 11, (full scientific names, italics), single line spacing.

References (not mandatory): references should be listed in alphabetic order, without numbering them, as reported in the examples below:

Ghittino C., Prearo M., Bozzetta E. & Eldar A. (1995). Caratterizzazione della patogenicità dell'agente eziologico della Streptococcosi ittica e prove di vaccinazione in trota iridea. Boll. Soc. It. Patol. Ittica, 16: 2-12.

Austin B. & Austin D.A. (1999). Bacterial fish pathogens. In "Disease of farmed and wild fish. 3 rd Ed.", Praxis Publishing, Chichester, England.

Abbreviations for Scientific Journals should be checked using "World List of Scientific Periodicals".

Layout:
Upper and lower margins: 2,5 cm
Left margin: 3 cm
Right margin: 3 cm

The abstract in word format should be addressed to: segreteria.sipi@izsvenezie.it.

Authors should indicate in the e-mail the preference for poster or oral presentation.

The name of the file should report the Surname of the first Author followed by poster or oral considering the preference indicated in the e-mail (Example: Rossi_Poster.doc or Bianchi_oral.doc).

Abstract will not be submitted to a preliminary review. For this reason, authors are responsible for the information reported.
