

## **INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA pursuant to EU Regulation 679/2016**

The Scientific Association "Italian Society of Fish Pathology" (SIPI), with registered office in Turin, in agreement with the EU Regulation 679/2016 and as Data Controller, announces the following information regarding the management of personal data.

### **Premised that**

1. The Italian Society of Fish Pathology (SIPI) was founded in 1987 in Padua. SIPI has the purpose of promoting, encouraging and developing studies on aquatic animals pathology and related topics. Moreover, SIPI is actively involved in the creation of national and international networks involving researchers, stakeholders and institutions, in order to promote and coordinate the interactions among them.
2. Personal data are recorded at the SIPI secretariat
3. SIPI is aligned with the high standards of confidentiality of personal data introduced by the European Data Protection Regulation (EU Reg. 679/2016), based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of the privacy and rights of the data related to the interested party.
4. In the light of the aforementioned legislation, it is not necessary to give consent for the data to continue to be registered to SIPI database, in consideration of the legitimate interest underlying the registration to the Society.
5. SIPI collects and uses, in carrying out its institutional activities, personal data (i.e. name, surname, title, role / position, address, telephone, e-mail address) related to members of the Society and companies supporting the Society, to their respective directors, managers, employees, collaborators and consultants. This information were transmitted by the shareholders in compliance with the obligations that are imposed on the members or were collected directly by the Company (for example in the occasion of participation to meetings, events or conferences) and are used for invitations to meetings, events, courses, conferences, as well as the sending newsletters.
6. S.I.P.I. guarantees to each interested party the exercise of its rights on/of:
  - Access to personal data
  - Editing or cancellation or limitation to data treatment

- Oppose data treatment;
- Data portability;
- Revoke the consent: where provided, the revocation of the consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the revocation;
- Complaint with the supervisory authority (Privacy Guarantor)

## **SIPI INFORMS THAT**

### **I. Data Controller and Data Processor**

The Data Controller and Data Processor is the Scientific Association "Italian Society of Fish Pathology", with registered office at IZS del Piemonte, Liguria and Valle d'Aosta, Via Bologna, 148, 10154 Turin.

### **II. Purpose of the processing and categorization of data**

The data processed by the Data Controller are managed accordingly to the associative relationship and, in any case, aimed at pursuing the institutional purposes of SIPI: statutory, administrative and associative management in general; to inform about SIPI initiatives, activities and projects (meetings, conferences, workshops, etc.), to send information material and newsletters, in any case for other institutional activity promoted by SIPI which in any case ensures correct and lawful processing of data, safeguarding its confidentiality and integrity.

### **III. Processing methods and storage time**

The processing of personal data, owned by SIPI, and in charge of each of its employees or collaborators, is aimed at managing the associative relationship and can be carried out with or without the aid of electronic or automated means. This treatment will include, in compliance with the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of confidentiality, the operations strictly necessary for the purpose. The provision of identification data is necessary to carry out the associative relationship and any refusal to provide such information could result in the failure or partial execution of the activities mentioned in the Association's Statute. The data will be kept for the period necessary to carry out the formalities referred in the previous point. Personal data will not be disseminated.

### **IV. Rights of the individual/subject**

The EU Privacy Regulation 679/2016 provides the subject specific rights, including those to ask the Data Controller: cancellation, transformation into anonymous form and blocking of data processed in

violation of the law, request the updating or rectification or integration, to oppose their use, to obtain the updated list of Data Processors, to obtain data portability, access to the supervisory authority, to make a complaint.
