

SIPI statute synthesis

The present document summarises the content of the original statute provided in the Italian version of the SIPI website (<https://www.sipi-online.it/sipi/>). The articles from 1 to 17 report information on S.I.P.I. definition, society headquarters – based in TORINO-, society main purposes and scientific focus. Affiliates/members can be vets, scientists, students, other professional figures, as well as private/public institutions, specifically involved in the field of fish pathology/aquaculture. Affiliates can be part of the society as ordinary or, alternatively, supporting members. The instruction and details for the affiliation are provided in the S.I.P.I. section of the website. S.I.P.I. can be further associated and connected with other scientific societies pursuing the same objectives. The official organs of SIPI are: Assemblea, Presidente, Consiglio Direttivo, Collegio dei Sindaci, Proviviri. The articles from 9 to 14 of the statute specifically define the role of each organ. The article 15 deals with the economic issues concerning the society. The common fund consists in the members annual affiliation fees, the budget surplus deriving from the previous year, the financial supports eventually provided by private or public institutions. The common fund cannot be distributed externally to the society. The association can be dissolved only upon the agreement of at least 70% of the members. In that case, the residual common fund will be addressed to an alternative society having similar objectives/field of interest.
